In 2019, U.Porto Innovation completed 15 years of dedication to the University of Porto's knowledge transfer. We are proud of the valorisation results we have accomplished and we are grateful to all who have contributed to them. Aiming to celebrate our anniversary, we launched a media campaign consisting of the weekly publication of "Innovation in a Minute" movies, showing the University's technologies.

In this past year, U.Porto Innovation promoted events that energized the innovation ecosystem. We hosted the premiere in Portugal of the Digital Health Venture Forum, which gathered 150 entrepreneurs and investors in Porto Business School. We boosted the participation of U.Porto's students in the European Innovation Academy, an international summer school dedicated to entrepreneurship, which is sponsored by Santander Universidades. We have also organized the second edition of Entreprenow, our flagship event that surpassed 150 participants interested in discussing and getting to know the entrepreneurial journey. This event, and its accomplishments, were only possible due to the support from Santander Universidades and ScaleUp Porto. Also during this period, 46 projects, selected in competitive calls, enhanced U.Porto Innovation activities. Their budgets correspond, in total, to 2 million EUR of investment in intellectual property protection, technology transfer, and entrepreneurship. Two new projects started in 2019: Sherpa do Mar and Spin UP. Both projects strive for knowledge valorisation in the cross-border region between Portugal and Spain. These are among U.Porto Innovation 2019 achievements highlighted in the present brochure. Enjoy it!

DIGITAL HEALTH VENTURE FORUM



INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY NUMBERS [2019]




