This U.Porto programme supports the transformation of innovative academic technologies into business models. The main goal is to turn ideas into economically feasible products and services that will play a role in shaping the world of tomorrow.

During the 12 weeks of each Business Ignition Programme (BIP), all participants have access to specialist business training and dedicated mentor

supervision. These mentors come from different areas of expertise to help the teams. In 2017, U.Porto Innovation co-organized two editions of Business Ignition Programme and supported 20 projects. Five of those 20 participating ideas were awarded in the finals.

Constança Paúl: Social innovation



What can I get from U.Porto Innovation?




