

INOVAÇÃO

In 2021 the pandemia did not prevent U.Porto Innovation to perform its mission. While working from home and organizing online initiatives had a positive balance, at the same time we were back on track in the organization of crowded onsite events.

Intellectual property is part of our DNA. We want the same for University of Porto's community genetic code. That's why we launched FAQs about patents, a new publication to raise awareness and inform about the basics in patenting. Returns are coming. In 2021 U.Porto beat its record in inventions, with 51 disclosures throughout the year, and executed new 6 knowledge transfer agreements with industry.

On the entrepreneurial front, we highlight U.Porto's participation at StageTwo, the first pan-european competition for university startups, in Berlin. Beyond the "business as usual" our team contributed for U.Porto's objective of promoting entrepreneurship with impact. We organized a full day workshop on the United Nations 2030 Sustainable Development Goals. We also collaborated on the first edition of UP Santander Inspira-te, a training programme in social impact. Last year was full of interactions with industry. Inside The Circle Club our team mingled with U. Porto spin-offs in a sales training course U. Porto offered and, of course, in the gathering of the Club at the conference BIN @ Porto 2021. In addition, our team co-hosted 4 networking events between scientists and companies' executives, in cooperation with ANJE - Portuguese Association of Young Entrepreneurs, and 3 academia-industry gatherings in the marine and maritime sector.

Most of our actions were developed in coordination or had the support of partner institutions. That brings to light the collective effort to recover and to rise off the ground the innovation ecosystem. Check more evidences in the present report and much more on U. Porto Innovation media.

PARTNERSHIP WITH DIGESTAID

University of Porto and DIGESTAID sealed a partnership aiming the valorization of six artificial intelligence patents with relevant applications in the field of gastroenterology. DIGESTAID is a start-up company founded in 2021. The patents were invented by a multidisciplinary team of gastroenterologists and engineers from the Faculties of Engineering and Medicine and from the University Hospital Center of São João.

In 2021 a new video was produced, as well as a new website, with a complete redesign and updated contents.



INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY NUMBERS [2021]









