During 2023 the U.Porto Innovation, recently integrated into the Vice- Rectorate for Research and Innovation, renewed its vision in order to better fulfil its mission within the research and innovation ecosystem of the University.

Visibility and proximity will be the cornerstones of this renewed vision.

Regarding visibility; the goal is to ensure that the activities of U.Porto Innovation, focused on research results valorisation and innovation, are both known and recognized, reaching all the players of the U.Porto research ecosystem. A challenging task, given that U.Porto Innovation operates within a dynamic and diverse network, involving numerous stakeholders, accounting for nearly 25% of the scientific output produced in Portugal.

Concerning proximity; the aim is to work closely with our scientific community and raise the awareness of the issues addressed by U.Porto Innovation, namely, intellectual property protection, business development and technology transfer. The increased embracement by the U.Porto research ecosystem of these subjects, will positively impact the level of innovation generated at our University. The work and activities undertaken by U.Porto Innovation in 2023 are already contributing to this vision.

In the year 2023 U.Porto Innovation operated at full capacity. Our team grew to 13 members, the largest size ever. This expansion translated into enhanced responsiveness in supporting the University of Porto's research and innovation ecosystem.

Indeed, we managed 592 intellectual property protection and commercialization projects stemming from University of Porto Science. All these projects give body to a top intangible assets' portfolio in Portugal.

The business development of University of Porto intellectual property portfolio goes hand in hand with University's internationalization investments. This is the explanation for U.Porto's leadership in the 2023 Gastão da Cunha Ferreira Index for international patenting.

Moreover, U.Porto Innovation implemented 5 seasonal programmes, namely, the ninth edition of the business idea competition iup25k, the seventh edition of the open innovation programme IJUP Empresas, the sixth edition of the proof of concept programme BIP Proof, the second edition of the ignition programme BIP Ignition and the second edition of the acceleration programme BIP Acceleration. Last year we also dedicated considerable attention to nurturing relations with University of Porto stakeholders. Specifically, we organized a record number of 14 Academia to Business sessions, aiming research and innovation partnerships with companies. Additionally, 16 companies received the "U.Porto Spin-off" seal in 2023.

Furthermore, U.Porto Innovation amplified University of Porto innovation activities by the means of a number of communication actions. We count 22 events [14 A2B sessions included], 3 publications, 6 videos, 45 news and 73 public presentations. These figures reflect the proactive spirit of our team in 2023. U.PORTO WITH FIRST PATENTS GRANTED IN MACAU AND SOUTH AFRICA


In 2023, for the first time, a patent was granted in the name of the University of Porto in Macau and another in South Africa. The inventions were, respectively, from research teams of the Faculty of Sciences and the Faculty of Engineering of the University of Porto. The researchers believe that this protection is a huge step to enhance the transfer of inventions internationally.







